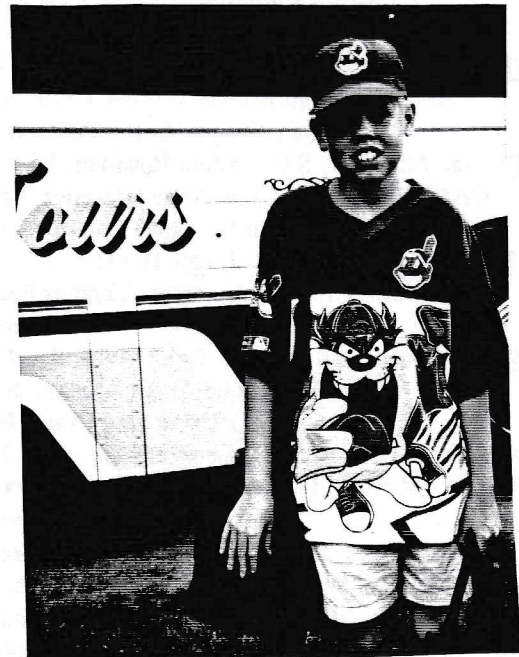
## New Beginnings at Camp by A. Ford

Mr. Birch founded the Polar Bear Club in 1982 and

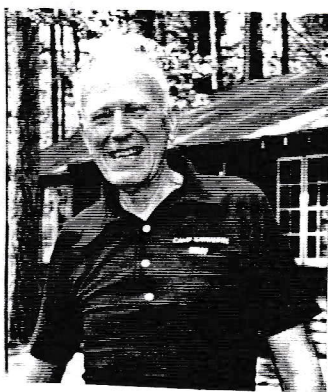

Both Brain and Steve thought they could see the "great red spot" (really a gigantic storm) in the clouds of Jupiter. But it was after midnight, and anybody might see red spots then — yawn!

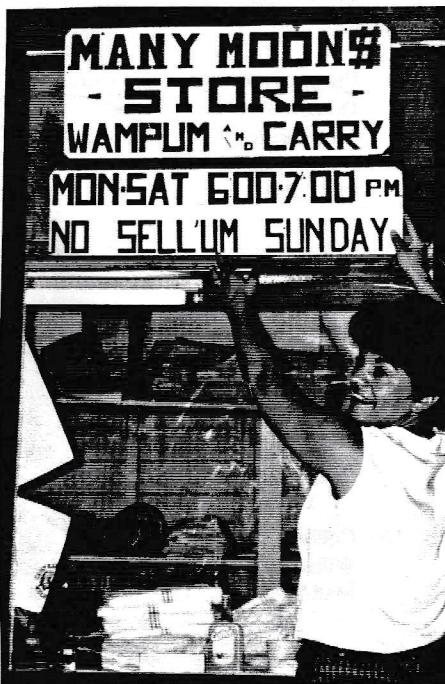
